Please have the student's legal name, address, phone number, and date of birth at the time of registration. All classes will begin at 8:00 a.m. and should be done by 1:00 p.m. (EDT). Students are required to bring a #2 pencil, a sack lunch & something to drink. Upon successfully completing the course you will receive your boater safety certificate. **Anyone born after July 1, 1996 is required to have a boater safety card to operate any vessel.**


